

One Button Ear Saver:



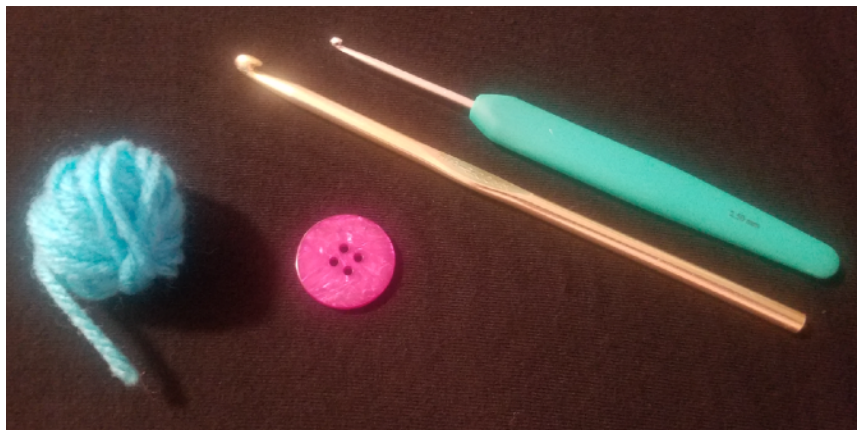
Materials:

1 button ($\frac{3}{4}$ " - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " diameter)

About 9ft of yarn (between weight 3 and 5. The example uses an aran weight yarn #4)

Size H/8 crochet hook (5.0mm)

Tapestry needle, small crochet hook, tape, wire, or some other method to thread yarn through the button holes.



Shorthand Key:

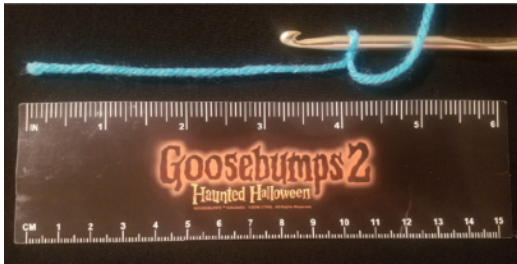
cs: chain stitch
hdc: half-double crochet
sc: single crochet
dc: double crochet
sl: slip stitch

Steps:

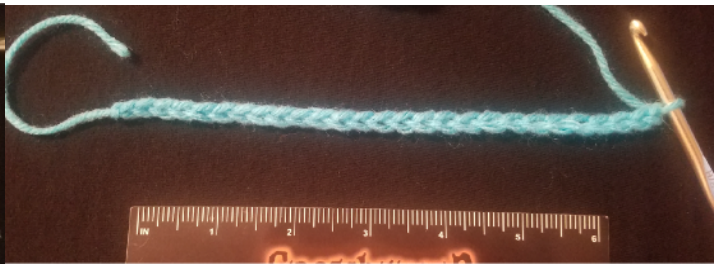
- 1) Start your crochet with a slipknot with about 4" of tail.
- 2) cs 27

- 3) sc into the eighth stitch from the hook
- 4) 2sc 5hdc 9dc 3hdc, ending on the first chain stitch.
- 5) Cut the yarn to about 4" and bring it through the loop to finish the crochet.
- 6) Use the yarn ends to attach the button. Double knot and weave in ends to finish.

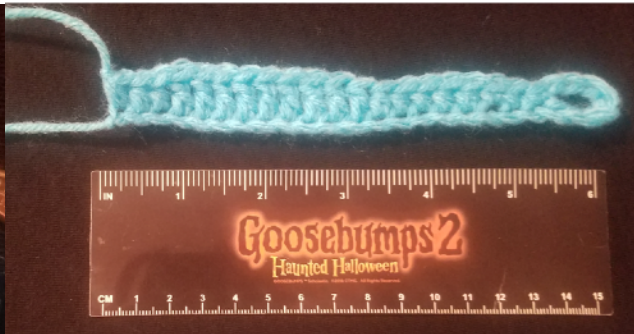
